

I Strategy

Our institution has focused on students mobility for the last few years. In the following years' time we would like to expand our international cooperation, introducing multilateral projects and thematic networks project.

We also intend to start cooperation with new foreign educational institutions in order to make our offer more attractive and enhance mobility.

We hope that cooperation with new partners will let more students go abroad and it will enable teachers mobility enhancement.

In the nearest future we are planning to introduce e-learning system which will hopefully let us offer an opportunity to take up studies by the elderly, disabled or working people.

Our offer includes a wide range of social and educational scholarships which allow students of all social and economic backgrounds to have equal chances to learn.

Our institution complies with non-discrimination objectives, especially in case of gender equality. The number of female students is almost the same as male students. Our aim is to offer a chance to learn to students of all nationalities and races, the reflection of which is the fact that foreign students take up studies in our school every year.

II Quality of Academic mobility activities

In order to ensure high quality of students mobility we offer our candidates a language preparation course at a partner university. Such a course allows the students not only to develop their language skills, but also to find out information on the institution, the coordinator, accommodation facilities, as well as establish new relationships and contacts.

Prior to taking part in a language preparation course, the students are acknowledged of studying conditions, accommodation, counseling, financial support, curricula as well as credit system.

During their studies abroad students are provided with home institution coordinator's support in all aspects concerning the mobility.

Our institution has implemented ECTS which applies to all outgoing and home students.

III Quality of student placement activities

All our students usually take part in student placements offered by the home institution. The Students' Union offers information on a wide range of placements as well as training courses for students.
